This permit is not valid on State Highways or the roadway crossing under or over a State Freeway. A separate moving permit is required from the State.

This permit is not valid on streets or bridges which have posted weight limits.

- NIGHT MOVES. Any load moved during nighttime hours shall meet all requirements of State and County
 regulations and shall be properly lighted with warning lights and signs as may be required by law and ordinance.
- 3. PARKING OF VEHICLE. Permittee shall not, during restricted hours or at any other time, stand nor park the permitted vehicle where it creates a hazard or traffic obstruction. If the vehicle is in one of the above-mentioned areas at the beginning of a restricted movement, it shall continue to move, following the permitted route, using reasonable care and precaution to prevent traffic disruption, to the nearest suitable location to where the load may be parked for the duration of the restricted period.
- 4. MOVING IN INCLEMENT WEATHER. Movement shall not occur in snow, fog, rain, or wind when visibility is restricted to less than 1,000 feet (304.8 meters). Movement is prohibited when road surfaces are hazardous due to rain, ice, snow or frost, or when use of tire chains is mandatory. In addition, manufactured housing shall not move when the velocity of the wind is such that it causes the vehicle being towed to whip or swerve from side-to-side or fail to follow substantially in the path of the towing vehicle, if inclement weather is encountered during the movement of the vehicle, it shall continue to move, using reasonable care and precaution to prevent traffic disruption, to the nearest suitable location to where the load may be parked until the inclement weather passes. The speed limit shall not exceed 25 mph or the posted speed whichever is less when moving to park at the nearest suitable location.
- 5. OPERATING HOURS. This permit is valid within the period stated on the face of the permit. Unless specifically stated otherwise (See Section III, Overwidth), moving is prohibited from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m to 6 p.m.; and from noon Saturday until 11 p.m. Sunday. No moving during the following holidays:

New Years Fourth of July Thanksgiving (and following day)
Memorial Day Labor Day Christmas
(National Observation)

- 6. PERMIT TO BE CARRIED ON VEHICLE. This permit is valid only when it is carried on the permitted vehicle.
- 7. PERMIT SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. This permit is the property of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works and must be surrendered upon demand to any law enforcement officer or employee of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works charged with the care and protection of highways.
- 8. COMPLY WITH APPLICABLE LAW. Except as specifically provided in the permit, the requirements of the Vehicle code and any other applicable laws must be compiled with at all times.

II. OVER LENGTH

1. PILOT CARS. Two Pilot cars are required when the overall length is 110 feet long or over, unless otherwise specified on the face of the permit. The pilot cars shall display additional signs as set forth in Item VI. One pilot car must be located in front of the move, the other pilot car must be located at the rear of the move. Rear steering trailers require two pilot cars when the overall length exceeds 125 feet.

- 2. RESTRICTED HOURS. Rear steering trailers exceeding 125 feet or any other load with an overall length of 110 feet long or greater will be restricted to the hours of 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. and may not move from 6 a.m. Saturday until 11 p.m. Sunday,
- INSPECTION. Rear steering trailers exceeding 125 feet or any other load with an overall length of 110 feet long or greater is subject to inspection by a Department of Public Works representative. The inspection must be arranged at least 24 hours prior the scheduled move.

III. OVERWIDTH

- PILOT CARS. One Pilot car shall be provided by the permittee when the load exceeds 12 feet. Two Pilot cars shall be provided by the permittee when the load is 15 feet wide or greater. The first pilot car must be located in 1 front of the move, the second pilot car (when required) must be located at the rear of the move.
- RESTRICTED HOURS. Any load or vehicle 16 feet wide or greater shall be restricted to moving during the hours of 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. and may not move from 6 a.m. Saturday until, 11 p.m. Sunday. Any load or vehicle over 10 feet wide, but less than 16 feet wide, shall not move between the hours of 7 to 9 a.m. and 4 to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday and from noon Saturday until 11 p.m. Sunday. Loads equal to or less than 10 feet do not have restricted hours under clear weather conditions.
- 3. INSPECTION / ESCORT. Any load 16 feet wide or greater is subject to inspection by a Los Angeles County Department of Public Works representative. The inspection must be arranged 24 hours prior to the scheduled move.

IV. OVER HEIGHT

- IMPAIRED VERTICAL CLEARANCE. It shall be the responsibility of the permittee to check all underpasses, 1. bridges, overhead wires, or other structures for impaired vertical clearance and to bypass or arrange clearance at such locations.
- OVERHEAD LINES. Permittee must notify the owner of all overhead lines that may be disturbed or damaged by his operation at least 24 hours in advance of the work. Arrangements must be made between the parties involved to ensure safe passage of the load.
- SNOOTER AND ROOF BOARDS. Snooter and roof boards are required from 18 feet high to above the highest point of load. Any load in excess of 20 feet must be provided a means of access to the highest point on the load.
- 4. PILOT CARS. Two pilot cars displaying signs the same as specified in Item VI shall be provided for all loads 17 feet high or higher. One pilot car must be located in front of the move, the other pilot car must be located at the rear of the move.
- RESTRICTED HOURS. All loads 18 feet high or higher must be moved during the hours of 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. 5. and may not move from 6 a.m. on Saturday until 11 p.m. Sunday.
- 6. INSPECTION. Any load 18 feet or greater is subject to inspection by a Los Angeles County Department of Public Works representative. The Inspection must be arranged for at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled move.

V. OVERWEIGHT

- 1. ALLOWABLE OVERWEIGHT. Axie weights shall not exceed those shown on the face of the permit.
- 2. All gross loads in excess of 75 tons shall not exceed 15 m.p.h. when approaching any crossing or structure.

VI. SIGNS

Unless specifically stated otherwise on the face of the permit, all loads or vehicles being moved in Los Angeles County under the provisions of Section 35780 C.V.C., exceeding 102-inches in width, exceeding legal length, or 1. 14 feet in height when loaded, or with more than 10 feet of overhang, must display appropriate warning signs. All signs shall be removed immediately upon completion of the move.

Signs shall be posted on front and rear of the vehicle or load and shall read, "OVERSIZE LOAD", "WIDE LOAD", OR "LONG LOAD", or as appropriate for front or rear overhang. The "OVERSIZE LOAD" sign shall have preference when a combination of features exist. The lettering shall be a 10-inch minimum height with a 2-inch minimum brush stroke and a minimum of 1-inch border all around. All signs must have black lefters on a yellow background mounted at least 18-inches above the road surface, front and rear. Signs must be neat, clean, legible, mounted securely and be visible from straight ahead or directly behind and from 45 degrees on each side thereaf. All signs must be illuminated for night moves or be constructed of sullable reflectorized material to be clearly visible to approaching traffic.

MINIMUM LIGHTING REQUIREMENT FOR EACH UNIT FROM SUNSET TO SUNRISE

- 1. Steadily burning amber lights at outer extremities, and all protrusions, and at five foot intervals completely around load except the lights in the rear may be red. Maximum height above ground five feet.
- 2. A minimum of the following high intensity amber electric lights must be in operation. These lights must be at least 4-inches in diameter. Approximate height above ground eight feet.

Left front (2 lights) blinker-steady or both blinking

Right rear

Right front (1) 1 blinker or steady

Left rear

- 3. Loads over 18 feet high require a white flood light projecting from the towing truck to flood entire front of load, adjusted so that lights will not project beyond maximum width of load.
- Lighting on <u>EACH LOAD</u> being moved shall meet these requirements.
- 5. These requirements may be modified and/or additional requirements may be requested by the inspector assigned to the move.

- Pilot cars maintain communications with the escorted load via two-way radio communication device,

- Pilot cars accompany the escorted vehicle over all operational California Highway Patrol (CHP) scale and inspection facilities.

2. Location

- If one pilot car is required, the pilot car precedes the escorted vehicle on two (one lane in each direction) or three-lane conventional roads. When a pilot car is required for rear overhang (i.e. more than 25 0"), the pilot car will follow the escorted vehicle. The pilot car follows the escorted vehicle on conventional highways having four or more lanes, divided highways, and freeways.
- If two pilot cars are required, one pilot car precedes and the other follows the escorted vehicle.
- Pilot cars remain right of the centerline of the roadway at all times.

3. Equipment

Failure to comply with all regulations under law renders the vehicle and/or load out of service until all necessary repairs or additional equipment is obtained to meet said requirements. Regulations include, but are not limited to the following:

- Identification placards comply with the California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 27904
- Warning signs comply with CVC 27904.5 and 35783.5
- Warning lights comply with CVC 25270
- Warning flags comply with CVC 28100
